Prayer of Confession:

Jesus You have revealed Yourself as God's chosen king. You have come to put the world right through a God-forsaken cross.

We confess that we often focus on ourselves. Our words and our actions are often used to impress others and pull others down. We gossip. We judge. It makes us look better than others.

We want to follow Jesus. He calls us to deny ourselves and take up the cross.

Instead, we nurse a sense of entitlement. We think we deserve a better life, peace and quiet, and respect. We argue when things don't go our way.

Jesus loves us. His trust in his heavenly Father is a mirror to reveal the true state of our hearts.

We often put ourselves at the center of everything. We make God and others the tools we use to meet our needs.
